Getting started:

- When it comes to talking about government and politics, where do you stand? Do you enjoy it, put up with it or avoid it?
- If you could change one thing about politics/government, what would it be?

Digging in:

- 1. Read Psalm 22:28 and Proverbs 21:1. How do these help when seeing the big picture of government? How might they help in this next round of elections?
- 2. Read Romans 13:1-7. What do you see in this passage as the purposes of the government?
- 3. What types of current day issues should the federal government be concerned with according to Romans 13?
- 4. Why does Paul say we are to submit to governing authorities?
- 5. Compare Romans 13:1-7 to Acts 5:27-32. What is the difference? What principles do you find for helping you to deal with authority?
- 6. What types of issues might force you to go against governing authorities?
- 7. What are the various governing authorities in your life? How have you related to them and how can you do better?
- 8. Using Romans 13:1-7 and Romans 13:8-10, how does God want us to relate to those people in authority that we don't agree with, value their opinion and hold an opposing worldview? Explain how this could be a powerful testimony.

Taking it home:

- 9. How can you honor and respect governing authorities this week?
- 10. Read 1 Timothy 2:1-4. What types of things should we be praying for? What will you pray for this week?
