- 6. Read Hebrews 13:2. What does this and the previous passages teach about Christian responsibility?
- 7. Read Luke 19:10 and Philippians 3:19-20. Why is our comfortable lifestyle not God's top priority? What is?
- 8. Read Luke 10:25-37. How does this illustrate how we are to love our neighbor?
