5. What was going through the mind of the third servant when he heard the nobleman was leaving?
6. What are the emotions of the nobleman as he hears about the servants’ investments?
7. How is the third servant’s report influenced by a faulty perception of his master?
8. What was the third servant’s reward?

Taking It Home:

9. What talents and resources do you think Jesus has left with you?
10. What changes can you make to your “investment strategy”?
11. How can this group pray for you?
