- 2. God wants us to be with Him. What does it say about God? About us?
- 3. God has particular way He wants us to approach Him in worship. Where do our own personal preferences in worship style, music, preaching, etc. fit in?
- 4. Worship without obedience, trust and repentance is empty ritual. How is our worship at risk in becoming empty?
- 5. Why did the sacrificial system involve death? Rom. 3:23; 6:23, Hebr. 9:26; 10:9-10. What does this tell you about sin?
- 6. Atonement means "to pay a ransom" or "wipe away." What was the purpose of atonement?
- 7. How do you see the Good News of the Gospel in Lev. 1:1-17?

- How can you remind yourself of the seriousness of sin and continual submission to the leadership of God in your life?
