

Leviticus 3:1-5

If his offering is a fellowship sacrifice, and he is presenting an animal from the herd, whether male or female, he is to present one without blemish before the Lord. He is to lay his hand on the head of his offering and slaughter it at the entrance to the tent of meeting. Then Aaron's sons the priests will splatter the blood on all sides of the altar.

Leviticus 3:1-5

He will present part of the fellowship sacrifice as a fire offering to the Lord: the fat surrounding the entrails, all the fat that is on the entrails, and the two kidneys with the fat on them at the loins; he will also remove the fatty lobe of the liver with the kidneys.

Leviticus 3:1-5

Then Aaron's sons shall burn it on the altar on top of the burnt offering, which is on the wood on the fire; it is a food offering with a pleasing aroma to the Lord.

The priest is to burn the fat on the altar, but the breast belongs to Aaron and his sons.

Leviticus 7:31

The meat of his thanksgiving sacrifice of fellowship must be eaten on the day he offers it; he may not leave any of it until morning.

Leviticus 7:15

1. Burnt offering: wipe clean of sin

2. Grain offering: expressed dedication and thankfulness to God

3. Peace offering: to experience peace and fellowship with God.
