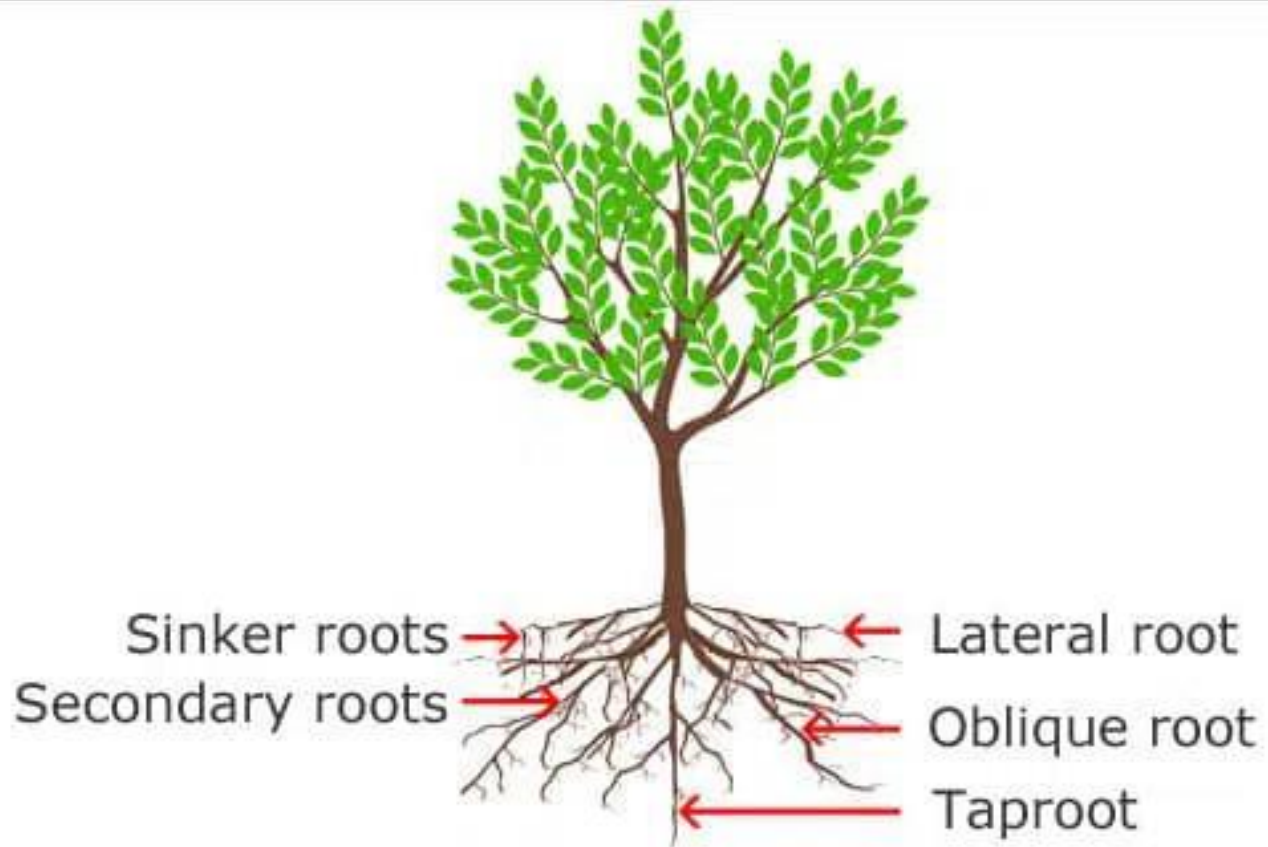
Walking with Christ develops deep roots
