Questions to Think About

- 1. In verse 13, Why do you think the man in the crowd asked Jesus to intervene? What does Jesus' response tell us about His priorities?
- 2. In verse 15 it says, "all kinds of greed." What are some forms of greed we might encounter in our own lives today?
- 3. The rich man plans to store up his surplus grain for himself. How do his plans reflect his attitude towards wealth and security? How might this attitude be present in our own culture?
- 4. Verse 20: God calls the man "fool" and reminds him that his life could be demanded of him at any time. How does this perspective change the way we should view our possessions and plans for the future?
- 5. What do you think it means to be "rich toward God"? How can we apply this in our daily lives?
- 6. Application: How do you personally struggle with balancing material wealth and spiritual richness?
- 7. Reflection: If you knew your life would end tomorrow, what changes would you make to how you are living today, especially in terms of your priorities and what you value most?
- 8. Action: What practical steps can you take this week to ensure you are being "rich toward God"?
