- 1. Read Matthew 5:17-20. What do you think it means for Jesus to "fulfill" the law? In what way did he fulfill it?
- 2. How do you think Jesus' statement about the Law and the Prophets challenges or affirms the way people approached the Old Testament?
- 3. Jesus emphasizes the enduring nature of the law in verse 18. What do you think this teaches us about the importance of Scripture today?
- 4. Verse 19 mentions that anyone who practices and teaches the commandments will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. How can we apply this in our daily lives?
- 5. In verse 20, Jesus says that our righteousness must surpass that of the Pharisees. How can your righteousness be greater than the Pharisees?
- 6. Read 2 Corinthians 5:21 and Philippians 3:7-9. How do you acquire this greater righteousness?
- 7. Read Matthew 22:34-40. How does this passage impact the way you think about grace and obedience to God's Old Testament law? Are they in conflict, or do they complement one another?
- 8. What areas of your life do you feel God might be calling you to a deeper level of obedience based on Jesus' words in this passage?
