Questions To Think About

- 1. How do you feel about praying out loud in front of others?
- 2. Read Matthew 6:5-8. In verse 5, Jesus warns against praying like the hypocrites. What do you think made their prayers hypocritical?
- 3. What were they seeking through their showy prayers?
- 4. In verse 6, Jesus encourages private prayer. Why do you think praying in secret is significant? How does it affect your relationship with God?
- 5. Jesus says, "Your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you." What do you think this reward might be? How have you seen your prayers rewarded?
- 6. Verse 7 mentions "babbling like pagans." What are some examples of ways prayer can become empty or repetitive, and how can we make sure our prayers remain meaningful?
- 7. How does verse 8 ("your Father knows what you need before you ask him") affect your understanding of prayer?
- 8. If God already knows what we need, why do you think Jesus still instructs us to pray?
- 9. Reflect on the balance between private prayer (as Jesus teaches here) and communal prayer in church or small groups. Why are both important?
- 10. How can you apply the principles in these verses to strengthen your prayer life?
