4. What are some ways we can slip into “just hearing” instead of “doing” in our walk with God?
5. What do you think it looks like practically to “build your house on the rock” in today's world?
6. What are some examples of “sand” people build their lives on today that seem solid but crumble in the storms?
7. Storms come to both the wise and foolish builders. What does that tell us about following Jesus and facing hardship?
8. Jesus says the wise builder “acts” on His words. What's one specific teaching from the Sermon on the Mount that you've found hard to live out—but want to?
9. What are some habits or routines that help you stay grounded in doing Jesus' words—not just hearing them?
10. Is there an area of your life right now where you feel like the “foundation” is a little shaky? What might rebuilding on the rock look like in that area?
