Questions to think about...

- 1. When you hear the word "faith," what do you think of? How do people around us (friends, coworkers, neighbors) usually define faith?

- 8. James says even demons believe the right things about God (2:19). What's the difference between knowing the right facts about God and having saving faith in Him?
