Questions to think about...

1. When you hear the word “faith,” what do you think of? How do people around us (friends, coworkers, neighbors) usually define faith?

4. Look at verses 15–16. Why is it easier to talk about helping than to actually help? What kinds of excuses do we often make?
5. Can you think of a time when someone’s actions—not just their words—demonstrated their faith to you? How did that impact you?
6. If someone reviewed your past week, what evidence of faith would they see? Where might they see a lack of it?
7. Jesus “saw their faith” when the paralyzed man’s friends lowered him through the roof (Mark 2:5). What would it look like for people to “see your faith” today—in your family, your church, or your workplace?
8. James says even demons believe the right things about God (2:19). What’s the difference between knowing the right facts about God and having saving faith in Him?
9. Where in your life do you sense God calling you to move from words to works this week?
