Questions to think about

1. Jesus called these men while they were working. How can following Jesus change the way we approach ordinary things like our job, family, money, time, or relationships?
2. Jesus says, "Follow Me, and I will make you..." What do you think Jesus meant by "*I will make you*"? How is that encouraging when you think about your own weaknesses or limitations?
3. What's the difference between adding Jesus to your life and actually following Jesus with your life? What might that difference look like in an ordinary week?
4. What are some things we tend to put off when we already know what Jesus wants us to do?
5. The disciples left their nets, their boat, and eventually James and John left their father. What does this teach us about the cost of following Jesus?
6. The disciples didn't understand everything Jesus was going to do, but they followed Him anyway. Where do you find yourself wanting God to give you the whole plan before you take the next step?
7. What is one next step you believe Jesus is asking you to take right now? It could involve forgiveness, an apology, surrender, serving, generosity, a relationship, or simply trusting Him with something you can't control.
