4. What are some ways our own desires or expectations can cause us to see a situation differently from the way God sees it?
5. What do you think "denying yourself" looks like in everyday life, not just in a big, dramatic decision?
6. Where are people most tempted to let Jesus ride along rather than actually follow Him? Where might that temptation show up in your own life?
7. What are some things people are tempted to hold onto because they think those things will give them security, happiness, or significance?
8. If Jesus really is who He says He is, what is one area of your life where you need to move from simply believing in Him to actually following Him? What might that look like this week?
